

TO REGISTER THROUGH YOUR CHURCH

1. The retreat will be held at the Nunemaker Center at Holmes Presbyterian Camp and Conference Center, a ski-lodge type facility with fireplaces, bunk beds and places for recreation. Some sessions will take place at the Lodge by Westminster Lake.
2. Registration/Arrival will be on Friday at 7 pm. Please have dinner before you arrive, as it will not be provided. Saturday breakfast and lunch are included. Retreat will conclude at 4:30 pm on Saturday.
3. A pillow and blanket are on each bed...bring a pillowcase. Any additional blankets, sheets, sleeping bags, etc. need to be brought with you. Also bring towels/washcloth/soap, toilet articles, Bible, pajamas. Remember: The temperature at camp is 10 to 15 degrees colder than that at home!
4. The \$50 non-refundable fee must accompany your registration form. **Make checks payable to your church. Give your form and fee to your church staff person.**

TO CHURCHES REGISTERING FOR A WEEKEND

1. Each retreat will be limited to 60 participants. A minimum of 20 participants will be required to hold the retreat.
2. Each church is expected to provide 1 adult for every 8 youth.
3. **Do not send personal checks for each registrant to Holmes.** After receiving registration forms and checks from those registering, write one church check made out to "Presbyterian Conference Association" and send to Holmes Presbyterian Camp and Conference Center, 60 Denton Lake Road, Holmes, NY 12531.
4. In order to register and hold your churches place, a **deposit of \$25 each** is due by **November 2, 2007** at the Holmes office, which is non-refundable. **All signed registration forms and full fees** are due **no later than November 16, 2007** at the Holmes office. All reservations are on a first come, first serve basis.
5. A waiting list will be kept and 1 week prior to the event, names will be taken from it. Fees held for the waiting list are refundable if the weekends are full.
